

Installation Manual

1 EXPLANATION OF SYMBOLS AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This manual has safety information and instructions to help you eliminate or reduce the risk of accidents and injuries.



Have the installer or dealer show you where the main gas shut off valve is located so that you will know how and where to turn off the gas supply when necessary.

1.1 Recognize safety information



This is the safety alert symbol. It is used to alert you to potential physical injury hazards. Obey all safety messages that follow this symbol to avoid possible injury or death.

1.2 Understand signal words

A signal word will identify safety messages and property damage messages, and will indicate the degree or level of hazard seriousness.



indicates a hazardous situation that, if **not** avoided, could result in death or serious injury.



indicates a hazardous situation that, if **not** avoided, could result in minor or moderate injury.



is used to address practices **not** related to physical injury.



indicates additional information that is **not** related to physical injury.

1.3 Supplemental directives



Read and follow all safety information and instructions to avoid possible injury or death.

Read and understand these instructions before installation of this product.

Incorrect installation of this product can lead to serious injury.

1.4 General safety messages

- When the cooktop is in use, the Cover must be fully open and in the upright position.
- The Cover must be closed when the vehicle is in motion.

⚠ CAUTION Do **not** use the Cover as a griddle or cooking surface. Doing so could result in property damage or injury.

For outside use of the D21 Cooktop, the Metal Cover is required. Do **not** store the cooktop outside.




4 INSTALLATION

4.1 Preparing the cooktop




- Remove the two screws holding the cooktop into the counter.
- Raise the cooktop to expose the mounting holes for the Cover.

4.2 Attaching the cover




- Thread the nuts into the cooktop bracket as shown.
- Tighten the nuts, being careful **not** to overtighten and distort the metal.
- Lower the cooktop into the counter and reinstall the screws.

4.3 Opening the cover



- Lift the Cover from the center slot. Raise it completely, then drop the Cover down to lock into the back of the cooktop.
- Unclip the wind guards, open them, and drop them into position between the cooktop and the grate.

4.4 Closing the cover



- Fold the wind guards, clip them together, and lift them up.
- Lift up the Cover, then lower it down onto the cooktop.
